COMMISSION

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You will recall that in the Pate-Palmer Weather Report the statement was made that it is not at all impossible that high yield weapons may trigger a self-sustaining circulation in the atmosphere similar to some of the minor tropical disturbances which occur in the Marshall Islands area. If further supporting evidence for this belief should be obtained on some of the Castle shots, I should like very much to have the capability of inviting Dr. Palmer to Eniwetok to look at the weather data on that shot, as well as to assist in selecting weather for later shots in order to prevent such events.

Although Dr. Palmer is not "Q" cleared, I can assure you that he can render this assistance without being given Restricted Data. However, it might be desirable for him to witness a detonation. Please take the necessary steps to permit us to issue this invitation to Dr. Palmer if we should find it necessary.
